Special Called Meeting Minutes
March 31, 2025

The mayor and board of Alderman of the Town of Alexandria met for a special called meeting on March 31, 2025 at 6 p.m. The meeting was held in the conference room of the Alexandria Town Hall, DeKalb County, Tennessee.

Fire Chief John Partridge presented the board with renewing the automatic aid agreement with DeKalb County. The automatic aid agreement would start April 1, 2025 through December 31, 2029. Motion was made by Jonathon Tripp to approve the automatic aid agreement. Motion was 2nd by Jeff Ford. MOTION PASSED.

Mayor Tripp presented the board with the city needing a civil engineer. Mr. Evan White has come before the board in a previous meeting presenting his credentials. A motion was made by Sherry Tubbs to hire Evan White as the town's civil engineer. Motion was 2nd by Luke Prichard. MOTION PASSED.

Mayor Tripp opened the floor for resident input on agenda items. Ria Baker of 104 West Main Street spoke on the Seay Church on Cemetery Road being a historical place. She presented the board with a packet giving them some information on the historical church.

Chris Corley, a former resident of 109 Goodner Lane, spoke on the widespread rumor that this meeting was being held to discuss bulldozing the church down. Mr. Corley has been in contact with the NAACP and stated they could aid us in the restoration of the historical Seay church.

Motion was made by Sherry Tubbs to adjourn. Motion was 2nd by Luke Prichard. MOTION PASSED.
