# Minutes for Meeting January 26, 2021

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Alexandria met for the regular monthly meeting on January 26, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was held via online platform, however the Mayor and Aldermen were all present in the conference room at the Alexandria Town Hall – DeKalb County, Tennessee.

The council members in attendance were: Lloyd Dyer, Lynne Dickerson, Charlie Fraser and Rusty Bradshaw. Quorum established.

Mayor Bennett Armstrong and Attorney Vester Parsley were also present. The meeting commenced with a statement from Mayor Bennett Armstrong, "On March 20, 2020, Governor Bill Lee signed Executive Order No. 16 ("the Order") extended by Order Nos. 34, 51, 60, 65, and 71, which suspends the requirements of the Tennessee Open Meetings Act ("TOMA") to the extent necessary to allow any governing body subject to the requirements of TOMA to meet and conduct essential business by electronic means if the body determines meeting electronically is necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of Tennesseans in light of the COVID-19 pandemic. Based on the above orders the Mayor and Board of Aldermen have determined that holding this meeting electronically is necessary to protect public health, safety, and welfare in light of the coronavirus."

Mayor Armstrong requested that the minutes from the November 30 and December 15, 2020 meetings be reviewed. Alderman Lloyd Dyer made a motion to accept the minutes for November 30 and December 15, 2020 as presented. Motion seconded by Alderman Charlie Fraser. Motion passed unopposed.

Mayor Armstrong opened the floor for citizen's comments. None in attendance.

### DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORTS

Water/Sewer Report was presented by Mrs. Elizabeth Tetlow. Rich Potter has all the supplies to repair the manholes in Hickman Creek. Repairs will start as soon as the water recedes.

Police report was presented by Chief Chris Russell; see attachment A.

Fire report was presented by Assistant Chief John Partridge; see attachment B.

Streets report was presented by Mayor Armstrong; see attachment C.

Financial Report was presented by Mrs. Elizabeth Tetlow, CMFO; see attachment D. Water Loss was discussed as there was an increase in water purchased versus water sold. Senior Center repairs were discussed.

Engineering Report was presented by Jerry Warren. Edgewood Box Culvert contractor was able to complete the culvert. They will be reviewing the break report to assess the timing of re-opening Edgewood Street. TDOT expansion of SR-26 lacks two (2) water and sewer easements from the Town. Mr. Warren stated that we should have these easements soon. EPA inspection reports were discussed. There will be a meeting between the Town and the EPA to go over the report. This online meeting will be scheduled in February. SRF has completed the financial review of Water and Sewer Department and the outcome appears to be favorable. CDBG application would be moving and replacing three thousand feet (3000) of sewer pipe from Sewer Plant to the tie in location. FEMA application would be from the West Main Street side of the creek to the tie in location. Town match will be approximately thirteen and a half percent (13.5%).

Alderman Lloyd Dyer made a motion to proceed with the FEMA application to assist in replacing the sewer in Hickman Creek. Alderman Fraser seconded the motion. Motion passed unopposed.

Attorney report was presented by Attorney Vester Parsley. Attorney Parsley reported that the TDEC Order has been responded to and we are in compliance with the current requirements of the order.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

Updated Zoning Map was presented to the Board. It will be digitized and placed on the Town website.

Resolution 20210126 - A Resolution to apply to the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development for Community Development Block Grant Funds was read by Mayor Armstrong. Alderman Fraser made a motion to approve Resolution 20210126. Alderman Lynn Dickerson seconded the motion. Roll Call vote.

Dyer – Aye Dickerson–Aye Fraser–Aye Bradshaw–Aye Motion passed

Finalized Audit/AWWA was received and reviewed by the Comptroller of the Treasury's Office and is now public record.

Departmental Budget Workshop was scheduled for February 9, 2021 at 7pm.


