The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Alexandria met for the regular monthly meeting on March 28, 2023 at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was held in the conference room at the Alexandria Town Hall – DeKalb County, Tennessee.

The council members in attendance were: Lynne Dickerson, Curtis Rutter, and Justin Chapman. Quorum established. Mayor Russell Bradshaw and Attorney Vester Parsley were also present. The meeting commenced with the Pledge and a prayer led by Attorney Parsley.

Mayor Russell Bradshaw introduced Mr. Donnie Bearden of 410 Locust St to the Board to be considered as an Alderman. Alderman Curtis Rutter made a motion to appoint Mr. Bearden to the Board to fill a vacated position as Alderman. Alderman Justin Chapman seconded the motion. Motion passed unopposed. Attorney Vester Parsley swore in Alderman Donnie Bearden.

Mayor Bradshaw requested that the minutes from February 28, 2023 meeting be reviewed. Alderman Rutter made a motion to accept the minutes for February 28, 2023 as presented. Motion seconded by Alderman Lynne Dickerson. Motion passed unopposed.

Engineer Report was presented by Mr. Jerry Warren. He stated that progress is being made on the sewer portion of the TDOT project, they are currently in front of 33812 Nashville Hwy. ARPA projects have been resubmitted to TDEC with their requested changes for the Meter project, Sewer Lift station, and Sykes Pump Station. We continue to work with TDEC to revise the applications. Wilson County waterline sale is progressing we have ordered the master meter and box. Chris Leauber at Water and Wastewater Authority of Wilson County asked about a tap install for a property owner on Liberty Hill that would like an agricultural meter installed. Mr. Warren requested permission to go forward on the installation of the tap. Discussion was held, Board approved installation without opposition.
