# Minutes for Meeting June 22, 2021

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Alexandria met for the regular monthly meeting on June 22, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was held in the conference room at the Alexandria Town Hall – DeKalb County, Tennessee.

The council members in attendance were: Lloyd Dyer, Lynne Dickerson, Charlie Fraser, and Rusty Bradshaw. Quorum established. Mayor Bennett Armstrong and Attorney Vester Parsley were also present.. The meeting commenced with the Pledge and a prayer led by Attorney Parsley.

Mayor Armstrong requested that the minutes from the May 25, 2021 meeting be reviewed. Alderman Lloyd Dyer made a motion to accept the minutes for May 25, 2021 as presented. Motion seconded by Alderman Lynne Dickerson. Motion passed unopposed.

Second Reading of Ordinance 2020-2 Amending 2020-2021 Budget. Public meeting opened to the citizens. There were no comments. Alderman Fraser made a motion to accept Ordinance 2020-2 Amending 2020-2021 Budget as presented. Alderman Dickerson seconded the motion. Roll Call vote.

Second Reading of Ordinance 2020-3 2021-2022 Budget. Public meeting opened to the citizens. There were no comments. Alderman Fraser made a motion to accept Ordinance 2020-3 2021-2022 Budget. Alderman Dickerson seconded the motion. Roll Call vote.

Mayor Armstrong opened the floor for citizen's comments.

Billy McClanahan addressed the Board concerning the water account at 146 Brush Creek Rd. Bills in question were those dated 3/22/21 and 4/20/21. The house burnt down, it was a rental and the bill was being paid by the renters. Mr. McClanahan is asking for some relief from the bill. Bill was reduced to ninety-eight dollars and three cents (\$98.03).

Mr. Richard Groom, 219 Academy Avenue addressed the Board concerning a neighbor's property 217 Academy Avenue. The neighbor's dog enclosure is on the property line and they are concerned about the smell and that the lot is kept cleaned up of waste. The Board will look into the issue.

Discussion was held concerning the Alexandria Fire Department Cookout and Motorcycle Ride being held on September 4<sup>th</sup>. Old Timers Day and Christmas Parade was also discussed. Old Timers Day will be held October 9<sup>th</sup>.

### DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORTS

Water/Sewer Report was presented by Mr. Rich Potter. Mr. Potter went over last month's water loss was fourteen percent (14%). They are searching for a leak off a four (4) inch main off Baird Rd. Replacing pump at the booster station it is currently leaking and should be accounting for about 4% loss. Replaced drive due to a storm. Flow meters at sewer plant have been recalibrated. We have an issue with one of the three blowers at the sewer plant. With a sewer plant update we

would like to replace the drives and operating system. Sykes booster station is in need of a gas powered generator. TDEC flushing reports are due before June 30<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Jerry Warren addressed the Board concerning the Wilson Water Authority and the Wilson County water lines. Discussion was held concerning financial issues and technical needs to supply water through a master meter. Discussion was tabled and moved to Workshop on Aug 3, 2021 at 7pm.

Financial Report was presented by Mrs. Elizabeth Tetlow, CMFO; see attachment D. Water and Sewer Report does not account for Depreciation Expense or Interest. Title VI training is ongoing.

Engineering Report was presented by Mr. Jerry Warren. SRF application will be completed tonight. Mr. Warren will be overseeing the TDOT Route 70 Expansion. Bid opening for the road repair at Industrial and Edgewood was held last month. Low Bid was ADC, Inc. out of Lebanon with thirty-one thousand two hundred and twenty-five dollars (\$31,225.00).

Attorney report was presented by Attorney Vester Parsley. Mr. Parsley spoke to one of the renters concerning the issue on Gin Alley. He had not contacted Mr. David Crook concerning his property.

Mayor report was presented by Mayor Armstrong. Mayor Armstrong met with TDOT concerning runoff issues on Route 70 and Locust.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

TOSHA inspection was the beginning of the month. The Police Department entrance was written up due to the handrails not meeting standards. Chief Russell is in the process of getting a quote for the repair/replacement of the handrails.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

Industrial Paving Bid Selection – Alderman Fraser made a motion to award the contract to the low bidder ADC, Inc. of Lebanon, TN in the amount of thirty-one thousand two hundred and twenty-five dollars (\$31,225.00). Motion seconded by Alderman Dyer. Motion passed unopposed.

Industrial Road Sign Replacement – The Town has received one quote on the replacement of the sign at the corner of Industrial Road and Edgewood Street. Tabled until paving is scheduled.

Alderman Fraser spoke to the Lions Club concerning the sign at the corner of W. Main and Rt. 70.

Tom Stewart addressed the Board concerning a draining issue they are having with their building on the Square. The Dentist and Library's downspouts are causing water infiltration in their building. Mr. Warren will assess the town's storm drains.

Alderman Fraser made a motion to adjourn. Alderman Dickerson seconded the motion. Motion passed.
