Minutes for Meeting July 25, 2023

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Alexandria met for the regular monthly meeting on July 25, 2023 at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was held in the conference room at the Alexandria Town Hall – DeKalb County, Tennessee.

The council members in attendance were: Lynne Dickerson, Curtis Rutter, and Donnie Bearden Quorum established. Mayor Russell Bradshaw and Attorney Vester Parsley were also present. The meeting commenced with a prayer led by Attorney Parsley and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Bradshaw introduced Officer Travis Bryant as the appointee to the position of Chief of Police. Discussion was held. Alderman Curtis Rutter made a motion to appoint Officer Bryant to the role of Chief of Police. Alderman Donnie Bearden seconded the motion. Motion passed unopposed. Attorney Vester Parsley swore in Chief Travis Bryant.

Mayor Bradshaw requested that the minutes from June 27, 2023 meeting be reviewed. Alderman Rutter made a motion to accept the minutes for June 27, 2023 as presented. Motion seconded by Alderman Bearden. Motion passed unopposed.

Mayor Bradshaw noted there was no Resident Input or Customer Hearings.

DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORTS

Police Report was presented by Chief Bryant; see attachment A.

Street Report; see attachment B.

Fire Report; none.

Water/Sewer Report was presented by Mr. Rich Potter. Mr. Potter stated that he has contacted a new laboratory, Waypoint Analytical, to run some of the required testing at the sewer plant. This change will be a cost saving and also render some of the sewer plant's equipment as obsolete. Basin Two (2) repair has been delayed due to weather. They are hoping to complete the repair within the next few days. Lift Station needs the line with the most recently repaired motor to be rodded out. The motor is currently struggling but the repair is still under warranty. The plants digester is full of sludge and is in need of its contents to be hauled off. It will take six to seven loads to empty.

Financial Report; see attachment C. Mrs. Elizabeth Tetlow reminded the Board that there is income and expenses for June still unposted to the financials. She also stated that the delinquent tax file had been sent to the State of Tennessee for inclusion in the printing of the 2023 property tax bills.

Engineer Report was presented by Mr. Jerry Warren. ARP TDEC has opened the competitive grant phase for the remaining monies. The project that falls within the requirements and being submitted for review is the sewer collection line relocation in Hickman Creek. Water and Wastewater Authority of Wilson County (WWAWC) is also applying to the competitive grant for a regionally expanded emergency water connection system and is asking for a letter of support. Alderman Bearden made a motion to support WWAWC in their application and implementation of a regional emergency water connection system. Alderman Rutter seconded the motion. Motion passed unopposed.

Mr. Warren went over a few possible ramp ideas for the side door of the Senior Center and a hydrant meter for the TDOT project.

Attorney Report was presented by Attorney Vester Parsley; nothing new to report.

Mayor Report was presented by Mayor Bradshaw. Mayor Bradshaw presented the fundraiser request for Constable Mark Milam. Alderman Rutter made a motion that the Town send Constable Milam one hundred (\$100.00) dollars. Alderman Bearden seconded the motion. Motion passed unopposed.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Resolution No. 20230725 – Adopting a Public Input Policy was read. Alderman Rutter made a motion to approve Resolution No. 20230725 as presented. Motion was seconded by Alderman Bearden. Motion passed unopposed.

NEW BUSINESS

Alderman Bearden made a motion to adjourn. Alderman Rutter seconded the motion. Motion passed unopposed.

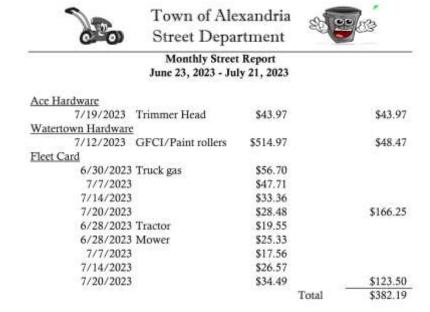
