# Minutes for Meeting August 24, 2021

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Alexandria met for the regular monthly meeting on August 24, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. The meeting was held in the conference room at the Alexandria Town Hall – DeKalb County, Tennessee.

The council members in attendance were: Lloyd Dyer, Lynne Dickerson, Charlie Fraser, Rusty Bradshaw, and Beth Tripp. Quorum established. Mayor Bennett Armstrong and Attorney Vester Parsley were also present. The meeting commenced with the Pledge and a prayer led by Attorney Parsley.

Mayor Bennett Armstrong requested that the minutes from the July 27, 2021 meeting be reviewed. Alderman Lloyd Dyer made a motion to accept the minutes for July 27, 2021 as presented. Motion seconded by Alderman Charlie Fraser. Motion passed unopposed.

Mayor Armstrong opened the floor for citizen's comments.

Lou Anne Snyder addressed the Board concerning the Pump Station on Goose Creek. Discussion was held concerning the cost and the Town's Developers Policy. Ms. Snyder will be gifting the Goose Creek pump station to the Town. She will forward the easement to Attorney Vester Parsley and the electrical information to Mrs. Elizabeth Tetlow, CMFO.

### DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORTS

Water/Sewer Report was presented by Mr. Rich Potter. Mr. Potter went over the Sewer Plant issue with blower number three, he is in the process of taking it apart and working on it. Discussion was held concerning the issues with High St Lift Station and the wipes that are currently still clogging the pipe. Adding additional needed telemetry to the water system will cost eleven thousand dollars (\$11,000.00).

Attorney report was presented by Attorney Vester Parsley. Mr. Parsley disused the Opioid representation contract that was emailed to him by Branstetter, Stranch & Jennings, PLLC of Nashville. Alderman Dyer made a motion to retain Branstetter, Stranch & Jennings, PLLC concerning the opioid lawsuits. Alderman Charlie Fraser seconded the motion. Roll Call vote.
